# **Kabel Deutschland acquires minority interest in PrimaCom AG**

Unterfoehring, May 18, 2007 – Kabel Deutschland Vertrieb und Service GmbH & Co. KG has acquired approximately 3.8 million shares of PrimaCom AG. This equals approximately 18.6 percent of the outstanding shares of PrimaCom AG.

The investment was made to preserve Kabel Deutschland's strategic options in relation to PrimaCom AG and in relation to the potential consolidation of the German cable TV market.

Kabel Deutschland (KDG) operates cable networks in 13 German states and supplies around 9.5 million households in Germany with cable TV services, making it the largest cable network operator in the country. KDG develops and markets new triple play services for digital television, high-speed internet access and telephone services via the TV cable. It provides an open platform for all digital TV broadcasters. The company operates networks, sells cable connections and provides a comprehensive cable network service. In the 2005/2006 financial year to 31 March 2006, Kabel Deutschland generated sales of over €1 billion and employs a workforce of around 2,700.
